Councillors agreed to match funding by way of supplying labour, hard standing, foundations and flags.

5 Planning

Ancient Unicorn Hotel – listed building application for alterations to internal layout and provision of 2 emergency exit fire doors.

Hylton Barn – variation of condition 2 (approved plans), to consider design alterations - approved Retrospective planning permission has been granted for the barn at Sleightholme.

Greta View Barn, Low Road Bowes – conversion and extension of barn to form dwelling with associated vehicle access. – We have no comments as long as approved materials are used in the construction.

6. Correspondence

Consultations stopped regarding the closure of the stroke unit at Barnard Castle and Bishop Auckland. E-mail from Youngs regarding trees in and around Bowes along with locked gates – Clerk to reply as follows:

I can confirm that trees have been planted in the field in the plan, but we were under the impression that this field was ours and have been for some time. I can also confirm that we did receive a grant of £100.00 towards the purchase of these trees but we do not envisage any problems if you need to cut them down at a later stage.

We will remove both padlocks on the wicket gate and to the field entrance to allow you free access.

It would be inappropriate to assume the matter regarding the allotment rental is closed as we are still considering our options.

Teesdale Action Partnership Board meeting agenda received – Bowes & Gilmonby awarded a £2,000.00 Grant

50% grants up to £10,000.00 for Armed Forces Day – as we only receive 50% we don't have enough funds to support a worthy project.

7. Cemetery & Village maintenance

Clerk contacted John Fenwick at DCC regarding the grass cutting and gardening in and around Bowes but they had no capacity for 2020.

A R Toward has quoted £960.00 for 8 cuts, same as the last couple of years.

Mr C Stamp quoted £1200.00 for 9 cuts.

Clerk to contact Mr Stamp, is he able to quote for the still born section in the cemetery and also the flower bed near the playpark.

There is a gap in the east cemetery wall at the end of the bank. This will be repaired in due course.

8 Allotments

Offered half of Callum's plot to the next residents on the waiting list, they no longer want it and have asked to be removed from the list as they are moving shortly.

The next person on this list has a home in Bowes but is currently not in the UK. He hopes to be back in the UK by May to oversee the completion of the modernization of Havelock House, he is hoping to move in before the end of the year. Clerk to contact them and suggest they stay on the waiting list until they have moved in as they will be unable to cultivate it this season. 23/02 e-mailed Steve to see what he thinks of this
