Bowes Cemetery Fees

Bowes Parish Council approved the fees below at its meeting in October 2024. The fees came into effect on 1 April 2025.

The fees for most services were updated to reflect inflation since the previous review of cemetery fees and represent a significant increase because the previous review was about 17 years ago. However, benchmarking indicates that the fees are still significantly below the average for cemetery fees locally, except for non-residents who have not previously reserved a space. The fee for these interments was based on the local average.

In June 2025 the Council approved an amendment requiring it to charge the full cost of any emergency work requested between granting permission for burial and the funeral without which the funeral director considers an interment infeasible.
